This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.16 dated 28.12.2019, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda.

Notice of motion was issued on 20.1.2020 and the petitioner was directed to join investigation subject to complying the condition as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
