The petitioner by way of the present writ petition seeks a writ of certiorari for granting succession certificate in her favour or in the alternative quashing the impugned criteria prescribed in Form-G wherein it is mandatory to get a succession certificate issued by the High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length submits that the e-mail/representation dated 05.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) sent by the son of the petitioner to the respondent-bank for clarification regarding obtaining the succession certificate from the competent forum/court prescribed by law is still pending and the respondent-bank may, therefore, be directed to decide the same expeditiously. He also submits that in the meanwhile, the petitioner would take the necessary step to obtain the succession certificate from the competent forum/court in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid, we do not find any reason to entertain the present writ petition which is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-authorities to consider and decide the e-mail/representation dated 05.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
