GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioners – Sarabjeet Kaur and Ranjeet Kaur have jointly filed the present civil revision under Article 227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for setting/modification aside the impugned order dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by Civil Judge, Junior Division, District Ludhiana, Punjab, with a further relief as mentioned in the civil revision.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the main grievance of the petitioners is that vide order dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-1), the Court of Civil Judge(Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, has deferred the hearing of the interim stay application under Order 39, Rule 1 and 2 CPC. He submits that vide the said order neither the interim stay has been granted nor the same has been rejected. He further submits that on 19.01.2021, the case has been further adjourned and the respondents had yet not put in appearance.

This Court, in the above peculiar facts and circumstances, deems

it appropriate to direct the trial Court i.e. the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, to take up the application for interim relief filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of *one month* from today.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of accordingly.
