The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

In response to notice issued by this Court to the official respondents, status report has been filed by way of affidavit dated 17.02.2021 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kapa, wherein it has been deposed as under:-

“2. That the matter has been inquired into by the local police and petitioners Amandeep Singh and Lachhmi Kaur have filed their affidavits and self declaration documents respectively stating that they had married each other on 20-02-2020 without the consent of their family members and had started living together as husband and wife at Village Mehiraj District Bathinda. It has been further stated by Amandeep Singh in his sworn affidavit that they had filed CRWP No.710 of 2021 before the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh against State of Punjab and others including Sukhdeep Singh, Daljit Kaur and other respondents but

now they have no danger from them and they do not want to proceed against them and that they do not need any security and shall inform the police if the same is required in future. Copies of affidavits of Amandeep Singh and self declaration of Lachhmi Kaur are enclosed along with its translations as Annexure R1(colly).

3. That similarly ASI Jagdev Singh of PS Sehna has recorded a joint statement of respondents Sukhdeep Singh, Daljit Kaur, father and mother of Lachhmi Kaur and also that of respondents Gurlal Singh, Mandeep Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Nirmal Singh and Gullo all of whom had stated that Amandeep Singh had married to Lachhmi Kaur about one year ago against their wishes and they had opposed their marriage but now they shall not interfere any (in) personal life of Lachhmi Kaur and Amandeep Singh and they can live at any place of their choice of their free will and consent. Photocopy of their joint statement alongwith its translation is enclosed as Annexure R2(colly).”

In view of the above development, no cause of action survives.

Petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
