The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of a direction to the respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to get a free and fair investigation conducted in FIR No.259 dated 08.07.2020 under Sections 294, 506 and 509 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as many as 5 FIRs are registered against the husband of the complainant, as detailed in paragraph No.3 of this petition. It is in order to mount pressure upon the petitioners to compromise those FIRs, the present FIR has been registered.

He further submits that the place where the alleged occurrence had taken place is accessible to the surveillance of CCTV camera and the recording of CCTV camera does not relate to the allegation as no such incident had taken place on the alleged date of occurrence.

He confines his prayer for fair investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without making any observation as regard the claim so made in the present petition, but considering the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to get the matter fairly investigated from a person not below the rank of Inspector. Efforts be made to expedite the investigation and to complete the same within six months from today.
