Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners who are stated to be working for the last more than 10 years.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case their Legal Notice dated 01.06.2020 (P-2) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondents and innocuous prayer of the petitioners is not opposed by him.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 01.06.2020 (P-2) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) months from today.
