The present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to refund the EMD submitted by the petitioner with respect to SCO-680, Sector 70, Mohali.

It is stated that the petitioner has participated in bidding process, which was held on 13.2.2020 and had deposited a sum of Rs.7,19,100/- with the respondents on 13.2.2020. However, the respondents in spite of submitting various representations and sending a reminder, which are duly received by them, have not refunded the amount and nor any information has been sent to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as representation of the petitioner and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within two weeks of the receipt of the copy of the order as well as the writ petition by way of a speaking order.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the amount, the same be released forthwith in accordance with law otherwise, the respondents shall pass a speaking order.
