GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner – Dinesh Kumar, stated to be aged 32 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer for quashing/declaring the impugned order dated 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 15.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3, with a further relief as mentioned in a writ petition.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 08.01.2021 (Annexure P-6), this Court had disposed of the similar petition bearing *CWP No.22774 of 2020* titled as '*Ajit Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others*' (in continuation of its earlier order dated 05.01.2021). In the order dated 08.01.2021 (Annexure P-6), it has been noticed that the Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Jind, who attended hearing on 08.01.2021, had given a statement that the impugned orders dated 30.06.2020 and 30.09.2020, have been withdrawn and the department will proceed in accordance with law.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would make a detailed representation placing reliance on the said order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, who is appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances as noticed above, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents/Competent Authority, to consider the representation which the petitioner intends to submit within 4 weeks from today and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of *two weeks* thereof, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
