Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to official respondents to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents and to arrest the accused persons in case FIR No.15 dated 08.02.2016 under Section 307 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural) and to present the Final Report/Challan before learned lower Court, and to protect the life, liberty and property of petitioner and his family who are under constant threat at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 7.12.2020 to respondent No.1-Director General of Police, Punjab, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 07.12.2020 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within two months positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
