Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioners, numbering 02, have come up in the present case under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of order dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned District Registrar Firms and Societies, Gurugram appointing respondent No.2-State Registrar of Firms and Societies as the Administrator of the Society of the petitioners, namely, Central Plaza Owners Welfare Association, Gurugram.

Upon hearing at length, counsel for the petitioners, the primary ground of the petitioners are that respondent No.2 had

adjourned the matter, in respect of their appeal, filed before the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana and on account of which, the petitioners would be denied their right to free exercise of franchise in the coming elections, which would be, as per the whims and fancies of the respondents, contrary to the objects and byelaws of the petitioners' Society.

Be so as it may, respondent No.2 is directed to prepone the appeal pending before the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana and dispose of the same preferably within a period of 20 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The present petition is disposed off in those terms.
