ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.15 dated 17.01.2019, under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that 02 kgs of charas were allegedly recovered from the petitioner. He is in custody for over two years and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over two years, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
