This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to take action on complaint dated 16.03.2020 (Annexure P/3) submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.3 and 4 for committing fraud with the petitioner by selling fake plot and took Rs.20,00,000/- from petitioner and no such plot is in existence on the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 16.03.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Civil Lines, Gurdaspur, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Civil Lines, Gurdaspur, to look into and decide representation dated 16.03.2020 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
