Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 and 6 and their associates, who trespassed into the property of petitioner by breaking the walls underneath the property of petitioner and caused undue loss and damage to the property on account of which dirty and sullage water is flowing into the fields of petitioner. By the said act of respondents No.5 and 6, five acres of wheat crop standing in the fields of petitioner was damaged and instead of taking legal action against respondents No.5 and 6, the petitioner was taken to Police Station Adampur by respondent No.4 Assistant Sub Inspector Surinder Singh and was unlawfully detained in an illegal custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 23.07.2020 and 06.01.2021 to respondent

No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/2 and P/4 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) District Jalandhar, to look into and decide representations dated 23.07.2020 and 06.01.2021 (Annexures P/2 and P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
