The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.81 dated 09.08.2018, under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station City-1, Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties with regard to the monetary dispute with regard to the sale of jewellery. He further contends that the matter has been compromised and a petition for quashing of FIR bearing CRM-M-9294 of 2020 has been filed and is listed on 15.02.2021. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when

the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, the petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on his doing so, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer till submission of report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.' - for short). The petitioner shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
