Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to take appropriate legal action on the complaints dated 20.05.2020, 28.10.2020 and 30.10.2020 (Annexures P-10 to P-12) respectively filed by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been repeatedly approaching the authorities concerned as there exists threat to his life and liberty vide aforesaid complaints. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide his complaints dated 20.05.2020, 28.10.2020 and 30.10.2020 (Annexures P-10 to P-12) respectively in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that proceedings under Section 107 Cr.PC have already been initiated.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the

petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.3 – Commissioner of Police, Faridabad to look into the complaint dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-12) and take necessary action, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
