The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking protection of her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the respondents No.4 and 5 are the relatives of the petitioner being her Bhabhi and Bhabhi's brother respectively and respondent No.6 is helping them out.

After notice of motion, a reply has been filed by the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that there is dispute between the brother of the petitioner namely, Jaswant Singh and his wife, who is also arrayed as respondent No.4 and due to this family dispute, the present petition has been filed.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it seems that there is a matrimonial dispute between respondent No.4 and her husband, who happens to be the brother of the petitioner. In the reply filed by the

respondent-State it is clearly stated that there is no threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of as such. However, it is made clear that in case, the petitioner apprehends any threat to her life and liberty henceforth, she will be free to file a representation before the police and the respondent-State is directed that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner seeking protection to her and liberty, the same will be decided expeditiously without any delay.
