The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the official respondent to conduct fair and impartial investigation on a representation dated 15.01.2021 pending with the Director General of Police, Law and Order, Punjab, Chandigarh and Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau, Mohali, so as to bring the application to its logical end after registering a FIR against respondents No.5 to 7.

At this stage, learned State counsel has apprised this Court that in fact the petitioner had grievance against respondent No.5-Brij Mohan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, who allegedly used to call Gurbinder (son of the petitioner) working with Punjab Police. He submits that said Brij Mohan, DSP, has been transferred from Gurdaspur to Barnala and, therefore,

the petitioner has no further cause of action to pursue the present petition.

The transfer of respondent No.5-Brij Mohan from Gurdaspur to Barnala, at this stage satisfies the claim of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
