Second petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.64 dated 22.02.2018, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner instead of pressing the present petition wishes to withdraw the same with liberty that the trial Court be directed to expedite the case.

Prayer seems to be justified.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the request to learned trial Court to expedite the proceedings and conclude the same within three months from today if there is no legal impediment.
