This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and independent enquiry on the complaint of petitioner which was marked to respondent No.3 with further prayer for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 09.01.2021 and 12.01.2021 to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/1 and P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, to look into and decide representations dated 09.01.2021 and 12.01.2021 (Annexures P/1 and P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
