The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.08 of 2018 dated 01.08.2018 under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered with State Vigilance Bureau, Ambala Division, Haryana.

The operative part of the order dated 20.01.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner relied upon the order dated 11.9.2018 passed in CRM-M-36072 of 2018, wherein the proceedings in FIR No.8 dated 1.8.2018 were stayed. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already deposited the alleged embezzled amount of Rs. 6,75,000/-, which is the disputed amount in the FIR.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there are no direct allegations against the petitioner of embezzlement. The petitioner was working under MOU with NIILM University, Kaithal and was only facilitating the students of Scheduled Castes for taking their admission in the

University and it was the University which has given the admission.

Notice of motion for 24.3.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 20.01.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from DSP Om Parkash, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above and considering the fact that petitioner is on interim anticipatory bail for the last more than one and a half year and he has not misused the same during that period, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 20.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
