The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 02 dated 01.01.2019, under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 25 and 54 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR which has been lodged on the basis of secret information that the police party tried to stop a Pick-up vehicle and the petitioner along with co-accused is alleged to have fled from the spot leaving behind the vehicle and the buffaloes. He also contends that the Pick-up vehicle bearing engine number as described in the FIR does not belong to the petitioner and he is not connected therewith in any manner.

This Court, by the order dated 27.01.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his/their arrest, he/they was/were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
