1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.217 dated 16.10.2020 registered under Sections 380, 411, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, expeditiously.

4. The same is not opposed by learned DAG, Punjab.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail being filed before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, by taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
