The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to decide the representation dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P11) and also to recall the attachment notice (Annexure P10).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1 Director, Department of Food & Civil Supply, Haryana to consider and decide the representation dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P-11) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 Director, Department of Food & Civil Supply, Haryana to consider and decide the representation dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to it, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to it, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
