This is third application for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out of FIR No.17 dated 30.01.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

The second application filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 02.12.2019.

Mr. RS Thind, DAG, Punjab, has submitted that the prosecution has already examined 8 witnesses out of a total of 11 witnesses proposed to be examined. He further states that the next date of hearing fixed in the Trial Court is 25.03.2021 for examination of remaining witnesses.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the Trial Court is requested to conclude the prosecution evidence positively within two months from today. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, is directed to ensure that the prosecution witnesses are available for examination on the date already fixed.

If the counsel representing the accused does not cooperate, the Trial Court would be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
