The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Harpreet Singh and Ravinder Kumar, stated to be both aged 27 years, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned Public Notice dated 13.01.2021 (Annexure P-3), vide which, the candidates for recruitment to 3704 posts of Master Cadre, as advertised vide Advertisements dated 28.02.2020 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively) have been granted an opportunity to make correction of the alleged mistakes pertaining to 'category' on or before 17.01.2021, inter alia, on the grounds mentioned in the writ petition.

Records of the case show that on 27.01.2021, notice of motion

was issued.

Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the reply, prepared and sent to him by e-mail, it has been mentioned that on 09.02.2021, the impugned Public Notice dated 13.01.2021 (Annexure P-3) has been withdrawn.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
