Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to initiate appropriate action against private respondents No.6 and 7 on the basis of representation dated 30.7.2020 (Annexure P/1) and against official respondents No.4 and 5 on the basis of representation dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P/3) regarding misplacing the office file (4185-PP dated 04.09.2020 DSP/Attari) marked by respondent No.3 to respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representations on 30.7.2020 and 01.12.2020 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/1 and P/3 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar, to look into and decide representations dated 30.7.2020 (Annexure P/1) and 01.12.2020 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
