Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 to 6 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by calling him to their office while interfering in the civil dispute at the behest of respondents No.7 to 10, which already stands filed, after enquiry as is apparent from report dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P/4) submitted by respondent No.5 and approved by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 20.12.2020 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/5, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, to look into and decide representation dated 20.12.2020 (Annexure P/5) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
