Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of 'pre-arrest bail', upon FIR No. 169 having been registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala, on 11.05.2020, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 326/323/148/149/188 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the State submits (on instructions) that the four petitioners herein have all joined investigation and presently at least their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
