The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.238 dated 05.11.2020, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 180 litres of lahan was allegedly recovered from his house when he was not present. He further contends that petitioner is not involved in any other case under the Excise Act.

This Court, by the order dated 01.02.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
