1. This writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari praying for quashing of the final electoral list published on 5.1.2021 (Annexure P-6) published by the respondents.

2. Today Additional affidavit of Harpreet Singh Atwal, Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Election Officer Sri Chamkaur Sahib has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5, the same is taken on record in which it has been mentioned as follows:-

“2.That the Present Affidavit is being filed for placing on record additional documents. Inadvertently in the earliest affidavit the said documents could not be filed. It is submitted that the publication notice under Rule11 was fixed in the Officer of Nagar Panchayat, Sri Chamkaur Sahib on 10.12.2020. A copy of said notice along with photographs is attached herewith as Annexure R-5/4 & R-5/5.

3. That it is pertinent to mention here in that in the

present case “Munadi” was also done from 11.12.2020 to 13.12.2020 under Rule 12. A copy of same is attached herewith as Annexure R-5/6. More so, the letter in his regard was also sent by Respondent No.6 to the deponent on 14.12.2020, a copy of which is annexed herein as Annexure R-5/7.”

3. In this view of the matter, nothing survives in this writ petition.

4. In our considered opinion, this is no warrant for proceedings this matter in the extraordinary writ jurisdiction. The petitioner, if so advised, may take their alternate remedy as per law. It is made clear that any observation made in the present order would have no probative value.

5. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed with aforesaid liberty.

6. Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending application, if any, also stands dismissed.
