Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.172 dated 30.12.2019 under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 21.01.2020: -

“...According to the prosecution, on raid 60 bottles of countrymade liquor were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel inter alia contends that petitioner was not apprehended on the spot. He has falsely been implicated. He is

ready to join the investigation...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Khushwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that challan stands presented.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
