1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail, as they apprehend their arrest consequent upon their bail having been cancelled by the trial Court on 14.08.2019 on account of their absence in a trial arising out of FIR No.241 dated 08.05.2015 registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram, under Sections 408/480/419/420/467/468/471/120-B/411 IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that their absence on the said date was unintentional and was on account of the fact that they had noted the date incorrectly and that they have otherwise been appearing regularly before the trial Court.

3. The petitioners pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 21.01.2020 are stated to have appeared before the trial Court and furnished interim bail bonds.
4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the fact that the petitioners are not stated to be habitual absentees and had been appearing regularly before the trial Court previously, the petition is accepted and the order dated 21.01.2020 is hereby made absolute on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
