MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner is praying for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty from her parents (respondent Nos.4 and 5).

Learned counsel has argued that respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of the petitioner, are forcing her to marry a person of their choice, whom the petitioner (aged 28 years) does not like. He has argued that the parents have given beatings to the petitioner and therefore, she has given a representation dated 11.01.2021 (Annexure P-3) to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala (respondent No.2). He submits that no action has been taken on his representation so far, therefore, necessary directions be issued.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the petition is not substantiated with any convincing and supportive material, much less the medical legal report of the petitioner. Even the other

relevant and necessary particulars are not contained either in the petition or in the representation. During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioner is residing with her parents and wishes to live with them but with security.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
