The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that he is entitled for the grant of benefit of 2nd Assured Career progression Scheme in the cadre of Assistant, which benefit has not been extended by the respondents to him though, he had already completed 16 years of required service. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, a direction needs to be issued to the respondents to consider and grant the petitioner the benefit of 2nd ACP.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with legal notice dated 10.01.2021 (Annexure P/8), which is still pending consideration with the respondent No.2 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is

issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide legal notice dated 10.01.2021 (Annexure P/8), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
