Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0161 dated 22.10.2020 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) (Section 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 subsequently added) Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.
