Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking cancellation of regular bail granted to respondents No.2 and 3 in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 25.03.2019, under Sections 308, 452, 323, 294, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that after respondents No.2 and 3 had been granted bail, they along with co-accused Karamjit Kaur had threatened and abused petitioner No.1. He also contends that the incident was captured in the video and the matter was reported to the police.

Heard.

The respondent No.2 had been granted bail after he had been in custody for over 5 months. The allegations were that he had thrown a brick bat at the complainant and the injury was found to be simple in nature.

Respondent No.3 had been granted bail after he was in custody for almost 6 months and stick blow on the left shoulder of the complainant was attributed to him. The alleged incident which has been referred to by the petitioner to seek cancellation of the bail of the respondents took place on 02.01.2020. There is no video recording although it is alleged that the incident was captured in the video but CD of the same has not been placed on record. There is nothing on record to suggest that after the incident which has taken place about 1½ year back, there is any other attempt by the private respondents to threaten the complainant or any of the witnesses.

Therefore, I do not find any good ground to cancel the bail granted to respondents No.2 and 3.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
