Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 08.01.2020, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act 1914, at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 22.01.2020, passed by this Court, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.01.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parmjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
