The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking direction to respondent No.4 to adjudicate the remittal issue as per order dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) in the light of the pending representation dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) for allocating the actual land in possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel informs that representation dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner lying pending adjudication before respondent No.4. Learned counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) in a time-bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the prayer made, we are not inclined to issue notice of motion. However, a complete copy of the paper-book has already been supplied to learned State counsel.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, respondent No.4-Tehsildar-cum-Consolidation Officer, Indri, District Karnal, is directed to consider and decide representation dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-3), preferably, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, as per law. Learned authority shall also consider as to whether the position explained in order dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) is applicable to the case of the petitioner or not.
