GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest consequent upon cancellation of his bail by the trial Court vide order dated 13.01.2020 in a trial arising out of FIR No.237 dated 02.07.2012 registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar, under Sections 148/149/302/506/120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that it was on account of the fact that the petitioner was indisposed that he could not cause appearance on the said date.
3. Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the petition on the ground that exemption application moved by the petitioner was

dismissed, as the petitioner had not furnished any medical certificate in support of his illness. It has also been informed by the learned State counsel that even on an earlier occasion, the petitioner had absented.

4. I have considered rival submissions addressed before this Court.
5. Having regard to the fact that it is a case where as many as 85 witnesses have been cited and out of which only 25 witnesses have been examined so far and the petitioner after his release on interim bail on 22.01.2020 i.e. since the last more than 1 ½ years is not stated to have misused the concession of interim bail, the instant petition is accepted and the order dated 22.01.2020 is hereby made absolute on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The petitioner is, however, directed to be more careful in future and to ensure that he duly appears on each and every date.
