The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 19.12.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 23.01.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not named in the FIR. All the injuries caused to the complainant-Gurjeet Kaur were declared simple. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

Notice of motion.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 23.01.2020, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhminder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
