B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the learned trial Court, to move an application for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail, in a time bound manner.
3. The limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by learned State counsel.
4. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail being filed, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
