Vide this common order, CRM-M No.3878 of 2021 titled
Surender and others Vs. State of Haryana and CRM-M No.5567
of 2021 titled Ajay Vs. State of Haryana are being disposed of.

Both the cases have arisen from the same FIR No.2 dated 05.01.2021 registered under Section 379-A IPC at Police Station Sadaura, District Yamuna Nagar.
