1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.283 dated 11.11.2020, registered under Sections 427, 452 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 09.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required. He further states that the tractor used in the alleged commission of the offence has also been recovered.

4. Learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 09.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail,

besides, recovery of the offending tractor has also been made and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, order 09.02.2021 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands ***disposed of*** in the aforementioned terms.
