SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02 dated 01.01.2020 under Sections 323, 325 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 308, 120-B, 148, 149 and again Section 380 of IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 29.01.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. It is debateable as to whether offence under Section 308 IPC was made out or not. He further states that petitioner is a lady and she is ready to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 03.03.2020.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall

be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, from ASI Sukhwinderjeet Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above fact, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 29.01.2020 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
