The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.218 dated 20.06.2020 registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Notice of motion was issued on 28.01.2021, the said order shall form part of this order as well.

The FIR was registered on the basis of secret information. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was total non-compliance of Section 100(4) Cr.P.C and now the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of order dated 28.01.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the

case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.01.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
