This petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been moved seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and not harass the petitioner at the behest of respondents No.5 to 9 with further direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide representation dated 19.01.2021 (Annexure P/2).

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner has been subjected to cruelty and she has been forcibly turned out of her matrimonial home. He further urges that respondents No.5 to 9 are now extending threat to the life of petitioner. He further urges that petitioner has already made representation dated 19.01.2021 to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, Deputy Advocate

General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and perusal of record, respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, is directed to consider the representation dated 19.01.2021 (Annexure P/2) and issue necessary orders, as warranted by law, so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
