1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel contends that despite order dated 20.05.2020, in CWP-7401-2020, directing the respondents to look into the representation submitted by the petitioner pending since the year 2015 and to decide the same expeditiously preferably within three months from the date of order, needful has not been done till date, therefore, the respondents are liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 20.05.2020, in CWP-7401-2020.

3. Issue notice to the respondents to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against them for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 20.05.2020, in CWP-7401-2020.

4. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has placed on record order dated 17.02.2021, rejecting the representation submitted by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who

states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 17.02.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. The same is not opposed by the learned DAG, Haryana.

6. In view of the position as noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
