1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 12.01.2021, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.
3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 09.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.
