Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present revision petition may be disposed of in terms of the order dated 10.12.2020 passed in CR No.2608 of 2020, which is read as under:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, has very fairly stated that the issue involved in the present revision petition has already decided against Union of India by a judgment passed in CR- 2249-2017 decided on 08.03.2018. Review application as well as SLP, against the aforesaid judgment, have also been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are not entitled to solatium at the rate of 30% and interest at the rate of beyond 6% per annum. He submits that, previously, this aspect was not taken up before the learned Executing Court, however, an application has now been filed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present revision petition is disposed of, leaving it open for the UOI to press the application pending before the Executing Court.”

As prayed for, the present revision petition stands disposed of in the same terms.
