For the reasons given hereinafter as regards the main case, this application is allowed and the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is advanced to today itself, with notice being issued in the application and Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepting notice on the asking of the court.

Though Mr. Anshul Jain, Advocate, had put an appearance for respondent no. 2, he is not present today but considering the fact that this petition itself has been rendered infructuous as would be seen further ahead, it is not considered necessary to issue notice to him.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a cancellation report has been filed by the investigating agency as regards the FIR in question, which has been accepted by the competent court, thereby rendering this petition infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Since counsel for respondent no. 2 is not present, it is made clear that obviously the said respondent, if aggrieved in any manner by the cancellation report, would have his legal remedy available (qua the acceptance of any such cancellation report).
